 - Dependent on interest and availability




Who We Serve

Over 530 kūpuna

• 25% on food stamps


Over 569 volunteers

- 30,000 volunteer hours
- Estimated \$950,000 in volunteer time



ELIGIBILITY

- Age 60 +
- Unable to shop for self (mobility issues or need to avoid exposure to public areas)
- Lives alone: no family/friends able to offer help
- Inability to order/pay for delivery services
- No duplicate agency support
- Not bed-bound (groceries delivered to door)
- Can communicate reliably with volunteer
- Referral from a social worker, case manager or medical professional





Kupuna Assistance Request

Who we ser

If you are over 60, live in Hawai'i and need help getting items such as groceries, medication and necessary household supplies, fill out this form and we'll connect you with a sponsor who can help get these items for you.

To be eligible for our service, küpuna will need:

- · Referral from a Social Worker, Case Manager, or Medical Professional with contact number
- Lives alone—no family or friends able to offer support (can help couples if both meet all the criteria below)
- · No duplicate agency support
- · Inability to order or pay for delivery services
- Need to avoid exposure to the virus/public areas, cannot get vaccinated, mobility issues to go out to grocery stores
- · Not bed-bound (able to bring the groceries inside the home themselves from the doorstep)
